A VARIETY OF PATHWAYS TO EARN YOUR DEGREE

Joint Degree: Students attend Culver-Stockton College or Quincy University to complete required pre-requisite courses and get the full college experience.

Direct Transfer: Students work on required pre-requisite courses at a college of choice and transfer directly into Blessing-Rieman College of Nursing & Health Sciences (BRCN)



REQUIRED PRE-REQUISITES AND ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS*

- English 101
 - Introduction to Psychology
 - Developmental/Lifespan Psychology
 - Anatomy & Physiology I and II with Lab
 - 2.7 Cumulative GPA
 - 2.7 Pre-requisite GPA
- *Other general education courses are required to complete prior to graduation.



PROGRAM LENGTH

Joint Degree: Students enter partner schools as freshmen, begin respiratory classes/clinical experiences with BRCN the sophomore year, in the fall semester, and earn a degree in 4-years.

Direct Transfer: Students transfer directly into BRCN, begin respiratory classes/clinical experiences, in the fall semester, and earn a degree in 3-years.

Students complete over 900 hours of hands-on clinical experiences and are expected to travel up to 125 miles to various clinical sites.



APPLY ANYTIME

Joint Degree: Students submit an application and high school transcripts to the partner school of choice.

Direct Transfer: Students apply online through the QR code and submit official transcripts directly to BRCN.
