





Joint Degree: Students attend Culver-Stockton College or Quincy University to complete required pre-requisite courses and get the full college experience.

Direct Transfer: Students work on required pre-requisite courses at a college of choice and transfer directly into Blessing-Rieman College of Nursing & Health Sciences (BRCN)

Second Degree: Students who have a bachelor's degree in another field of study, earn a BSN in an accelerated format.



REQUIRED PRE-REQUISITES AND ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS*

- *Other general education courses are required to complete prior to graduation



Joint Degree: Students enter partner schools as freshmen, begin nursing classes/clinical experiences with BRCN the sophomore year, fall or spring semester, and earn a degree in 4-years.

Direct Transfer: Students transfer directly into BRCN, begin nursing classes/clinical experiences, fall or spring semester, and earn a degree in 3-years.

Second Degree: Students transfer into sophomore courses in an accelerated summer format, beginning each May and earn a degree in 2-years.

Students complete over 700 hours of hands-on clinical experiences in the tristate area.



APPLY ANYTIME

Joint Degree: Students submit an application and high school transcripts to the partner school of choice.

Direct Transfer and Second Degree: Students apply online through the QR code and submit official transcripts directly to BRCN.
