About the program:

Blessing-Rieman College of Nursing & Health Sciences offers a joint Bachelor of Science in Nursing degree program in partnership with Culver-Stockton College, www.culver.edu and Quincy University, www.quincy.edu. Students complete nursing pre-requisite courses and general education courses on one of the partner campuses and then begin nursing courses as well as clinical experiences on the Blessing-Rieman College campus beginning the sophomore year.

Blessing-Rieman is fully accredited by the Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education (CCNE) as well as the Higher Learning Commissions (HLC). We also hold many other agency and state approvals which can be viewed on our website under the About Us section.

Admissions Requirements:

Freshmen need:

- 22 ACT score
- 3.0 out of a 4.0 high school GPA

You will start nursing classes the sophomore year after passing all first year required pre-requisite courses, maintaining a 2.7 cumulative and support course GPA, as well as achieving an ACT score of 22 or higher, or passing our Admissions Assessment (A2) Exam.

How to apply:

Begin by submitting the following materials to the partner school of your choice:

- Partner school application and BRCN application
- Official high school transcripts
- Official ACT scores

Once accepted at the partner, BRCN will review your file and grant you an acceptance.

You will take general education pre-requisite courses at the partner school. After successfully completing the freshman year, you will start nursing classes and clinical experiences the sophomore year at Blessing-Rieman. You will receive over 800 hours of hands-on clinical experience. BRCN offers small class sizes and clinical groups, along with personalized academic assistance.

Additional Information:

In addition to course work, students will complete over 800 hours of hands-on clinical experience in a variety of settings such as pediatrics, emergency department, the intensive care unit, and more! Students will learn skills as well as practice these skills at our Simulation Center. The Simulation Center has 9 simulated manikins which perform an array of life-like functions such as breathing, blinking, lung sounds, heart sounds, and even birthing a baby!
