### History of BNAA

The Blessing Nurses Alumni Association was established in 1900. It was formed to help graduates in need, to uphold a code of ethics, to promote the high standards or nursing and to encourage fellowship among the members. The **Blessing Hospital Alumni Association** joined the National Association of Graduate Nurses which became the American Nurses Association. A register of graduates was kept in the hospital office for private duty purposes. The 1909 Annual Report began listing the graduates and the position they held. Several were employed at the Soldier's and Sailor's Home, Woodland Home and the Visiting Nurse Association.


### **BNAA** Today
